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Current situation

- No specific initiatives or wellcoordinated actions among concerned government agencies;
- In need to catch up with other member states in many aspects;
- The 7th NSEDP 2010-15 earmarked cities:
 - development based on risk reduction and climate change adaptation;
 - economic growth promotion centers;
 - to accommodate rural migration and job opportunities;

Current situation

- National Urban Sector Development
 Strategies up to 2030:
 - Town greenery
 - Solid waste management
 - Waste water treatment
 - Sanitation and hygiene,
 - Infrastructure, housing; and
 - Urban administration and services
- Establishment of national ESC frameworks under the JICA-LPPO programme, from 2010;

JICA-LPPO programme

- To narrow the development gap toward ASEAN integration;
- To strengthen institutional and technical capacity of the national and local government for ESC;
- To build community spirit and establish national and local government links;
- Consisted of three components:
 - Agriculture;
 - o Environment;
 - **o Tourism**

LPP Environment component

- Establishment of ESC national guidelines;
- 17 provincial capital cities have been trained in creating ESC visions, strategies and action plans;
- Assisting 3 cities in improvement of waste collection and disposal:
 - Improvement of landfill;
 - Installation of healthcare waste incinerator;
 - 3 R promotion;
 - Demonstrative cases in composting, waste separation;
 - Exchange visits in ASEAN cities and Japan;

ASEAN ESC model cities programme

Year one:

- Promotion of sound urban administration and service delivery;
- Dissemination of simplified household waste water treatment approaches;
- Demonstrative cases in waste composting, town cleanliness and greenery.

Year two:

- Demonstrative cases in using Decentralised
 Waste Water Treatment System;
- Peer-to-peer exchange among CLMV.

Challenges and ways forward

- Fine-tune the responsibilities and coordination of efforts among government agencies at central and local levels;
- ESC visions and strategies shall be shared by all relevant sectors and have a place in NSEDP;
- Supports for more ESC concrete result oriented programmes (clean air, clean water, clean land);
- Support for institutional reforms and community empowerment in ESC;
- Extend city-to-city networking within ASEAN,
 East Asia and cooperation with other donors.
