


Green Growth in Cities: Designing National urban strategies

- To make urban green growth happen, national governments' role is crucial (Green Growth in Cities, to be launched in May)
 - National price signals and standards
 - Aligning local and national green growth objectives and harmonise monitoring tools
 - Mobilising private finance for green infrastructure investments
- OECD countries have solutions and policy experimentation to share (OECD National Urban Policy Reviews, NUPRs)
 - Poland, Korea, Chile


Functional urban areas: A challenge for horizontal co-operation
