NEXUS – The Water, Energy and Food Security Nexus

Improvement of city capacities for an integrated urban resource management

- Establishment of NEXUS Task Forces and advisory
- Identification and promotion of NEXUS Initiatives
- Development of standard procedures to involve NEXUS in new investment initiatives.

**FROM PLANS TO IMPLEMENTATION:
LINKING ASIAN CITIES TO INFRASTRUCTURE FINANCE**

- **Infrastructure programming and prioritisation**
- **Pre-Feasibility studies**
- **Identification of financial sources for selected investments**
- **City level capacity development**

CDIA was founded in 2007 by the Asian Development Bank (ADB and the German Ministry of Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ)



German Cooperation: Future Activities on ESC

Cities, Environment and Transport

- **Clean Air for Smaller Cities – 8 Countries**
Clean Air Plan development and implementation
- **Sustainable Port Development – 7 Countries**
Implementation of safety, health and environmental management systems in port (= cities)
- **Energy Efficiency and Climate Change Mitigation in the Transport Sector – 5 Countries**
Development of a regional strategie and national action plans for transport and climate change mitigation (cities included!)
