Recommendation

- i. We need the assistance and support from other resources, donors in term of extending and replication of project scope.
- ii. Awareness improvement need to be done in the long run, we also need the assistance in methodology and funding.
- iii. Capacity building for local authority and grassroots leader should be increased gradually.

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- We are doing this by sharing our experiences with peer districts and municipalities.
 - The Municipality has had a small budget. We will continue to mobilize local resources from bilateral partners (KAS Cambodia, CSARO, UN-ESCAP) and private contributions.
 - People active participation is the most important factor for success of beautifying Kampot City and improvement of people quality of life. Therefore, we need to organize more events (mostly community's outreach ones) on this theme. This includes public and community awareness activity, forum, consultation and public hearing.
